Die Zahl der deutschen Vertriebenen und Flüchtlinge um 1945 betrug mehr als zehn Millionen Menschen. Auch in anderen Ländern, allen voran Polen, gab es einige Millionen Vertriebener. Die Zahl der zwischen 1945 und etwa 1970 in solchen Flüchtlings- und Vertriebenenfamilien Geborenen, die sogenannte "zweite Generation der Vertriebenen", ist entsprechend groß. Diese Anthologie beruht auf vielen Gesprächen mit Vertretern der "zweiten Generation" aus Deutschland und Polen. Es geht um die Bedeutung der verlorenen Heimat der Eltern für das eigene Leben, für die eigene Identität, über lange nicht begriffene Erfahrungen von Fremdsein und Ausgrenzung. Oft übten die plastisch berichteten oder umgekehrt die unterdrückten Erinnerungen der Eltern eine solche Kraft aus, dass sie die Verwurzelung der Kinder an den neuen Lebensorten erschwerten und

traumatische Erfahrungen unbewusst auf die Nachkommen übertragen wurden. Die Texte in ihren vielfältigen Formen von Essay, Interview, Gedicht, Bericht und Kurzprosa zeugen aber auch von der Überwindung der elterlichen Erinnerungslasten und gelungener Selbstbestimmung.

This volume, in *Studies in the Social and Cultural History of Modern Warfare* series, examines how France, Belgium and the Netherlands emerged from the military collapse and humiliating Nazi occupation they suffered during the Second World War. Rather than traditional armed conflict, the human consequences of Nazi policies were resistance, genocide and labour migration to Germany. Pieter Lagrou offers a genuinely comparative approach to these issues, based on extensive archival research; he underlines the divergence between ambiguous experiences of occupation and the univocal post-war patriotic narratives which followed. His book reveals striking differences in political cultures as well as close convergence in the creation of a common Western European discourse, and uncovers disturbing aspects of the aftermath of the war, including post-war antisemitism and the marginalisation of resistance veterans. Brilliantly researched and fluently written, this book will be of central interest to all scholars and students of twentieth-century European history.
