Créé en 1963 par Charlier et Giraud pour *##Pilote##*, Blueberry constitue la référence absolue en matière de Western. Le scénario est empreint de la plupart des clichés du Western américain incluant des rebondissements et des personnages pittoresques sauf peut-être pour les Indiens qui sont en quelque sorte réhabilités par les auteurs. À cet époque, le dessin de Giraud est déjà magnifique même s'il ne possède pas la teneur d'aujourd'hui. Bref, un album à la hauteur de cette série incontournable. [SDM].
