Le Rapport mondial sur les drogues se propose à aider les États membres à mieux comprendre les tendances mondiales des drogues illicites et vise à sensibiliser l'ensemble des gouvernements à la nécessité de recueillir et de notifier de façon plus systématique les données concernant ces drogues illicites. L'ONUDC compte sur les États membres pour lui fournir les données dont il a besoin, principalement en répondant aux Questionnaire destiné à l'élaboration des rapports annuels. L'ONUDC a envoyé cette année 200 exemplaires de son Questionnaire; il a reçu 118 réponses à la section concernant l'abus de drogues, et 116 à celle qui concernait l'offre illicite.

D'une manière générale, l'aptitude des États membres à fournir des informations sur l'offre de drogues illicites est très supérieure à sa capacité de fournir des données concernant la demande. En dépit de progrès louables, par exemple en ce qui concerne les estimations de prévalence, il reste encore beaucoup à faire pour pouvoir établir une base solide et fiable permettant l'analyse des tendances et des politiques suivies.

This book reconsiders the use of food metaphors and the relationship between law and food in an interdisciplinary perspective to examine how food related topics can be used to describe or identify rules, norms, or prescriptions of all kinds. The links between law and food are as old as the concept of law. Many authors have been using such links in creative ways to express specific features of law.
